



Dear Senior Parents,

Planning for Bahama Bash has started! What is Bahama Bash? It is a special, after-prom, substance free, all night party open only to seniors and their dates. This event is sponsored by the PTSA in an effort to prevent post-prom drug and alcohol related accidents involving Martin High School students. Previous years, over 600 students have attended. We are expecting a big crowd again this year. The party offers food, fun, entertainment and fabulous prizes, which all seniors have the opportunity to win. We're hoping to offer items such as MacBook's, laptop computers, Apple iPads, and a variety of gift cards.

All of these prizes are acquired through donations from parents, civic groups, churches, and local businesses. We need your help! Annually, seniors' parents are asked to make a cash donation to the Solicitations Fund, which is used to purchase items for the Senior Raffle, which takes place towards the end of the evening. PLEASE NOTE THAT THIS IS SEPARATE FROM THE VOLUNTEER REQUIREMENTS. All contributions are tax deductible. There are a variety of ways that donations can be made where your senior benefits too (with earned Bahama Bucks used to buy raffle tickets or purchase items in the Bahama Bash Gift Store):

- **\$50 Individual/Donor Donation** (Senior earns 1,000 Bahama Bucks)
- **\$125 Casino Table Sponsorship** - Your name, or your student's name, will be prominently displayed on a Casino Table in the Texas Hold 'Em Room. (Senior earns 2,500 Bahama Bucks)
- **\$300 Raffle Item Sponsorship** - Your name, or your student's name, will be displayed on a placard with a Raffle Item valued at approximately \$300. (Senior earns 6,000 Bahama Bucks)
- **\$500 Raffle Item Sponsorship** - Your name, or your student's name, will be displayed on a placard with a Raffle Item valued at approximately \$500. (Senior earns 10,000 Bahama Bucks)




